SIZES

Adult **Medium** [If you want larger size, use a larger DPN needles and if you want smaller size, use smaller DPN needles.]

GAUGE

22 sts and 28 rows = 4" [10 cm] stocking st.

MATERIALS

- **Worsted Weight yarn in a solid color only**
- Set of 4 size U.S. 6 (4 mm) double-pointed knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
- Stitch marker.
- Stitch Holder.

Right Glove

With set of double-pointed needles, cast on **42** sts.

Divide sts evenly on 3 needles, having **14** sts on each needle. Join in rnd. PM on first st.

Wrist Ribbing:

1st rnd: *K1tbl. P1. Rep from * around.
Rep last rnd of (K1tbl. P1) ribbing for 3 ½”.

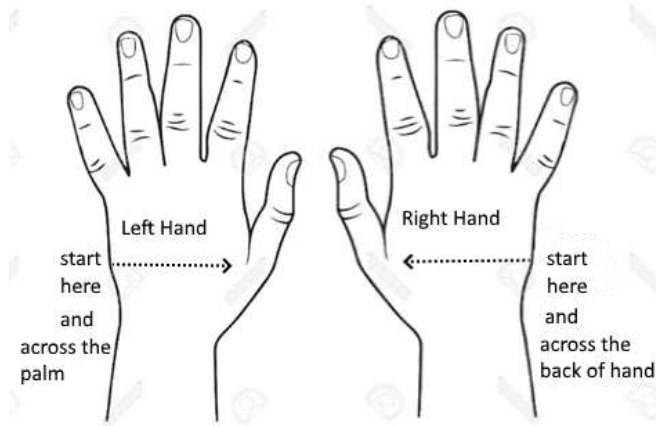
[Note: If you are putting a color contrast double stripe in the cuff:
1 3/8” MC, 3/8” strip CC-MC-CC, 1 3/8” MC = 3 ½” for cuff.]

do main color for 1 3/8”,

- change colors,
- K1tbl around,
- (K1tbl. P1) ribbing for 1 row,
- change color to MC,
- K1tbl around,
- (K1tbl. P1) ribbing for 1 row,
- change color,
- K1tbl around,
- (K1tbl. P1) ribbing for 1 row,
- change color to MC,
- K1tbl around,

Row 1: **[ZigZag:** K2, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K6] knit to end of row.
 Row 2: **[ZigZag:** K3, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K5] knit to end of row.
 Row 3: **[ZigZag:** K4, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K4] knit to end of row.
 Row 4: **[ZigZag:** K5, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K3] knit to end of row.
 Row 5: **[ZigZag:** K6, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K2] knit to end of row.
 Row 6: **[ZigZag:** K5, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K3] knit to end of row.
 Row 7: **[ZigZag:** K4, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K4] knit to end of row.
 Row 8: **[ZigZag:** K3, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K5] knit to end of row. **[42 sts]**

Shape thumb gusset:

1st rnd: **[ZigZag:** K2, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K6] [Gusset: **(Kfb) twice,**] Knit to end of rnd. **[44 sts.]**
2nd rnd: **[ZigZag:** K3, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K5] Knit to end of rnd. **[44 sts.]**
3rd rnd: **[ZigZag:** K4, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K4] [Gusset: **Kfb, K2, Kfb,**] **[46 sts.]**
4th rnd: **[ZigZag:** K5, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K3] knit to end of rnd. **[46 sts]**
5th rnd: **[ZigZag:** K6, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K2] [Gusset: **Kfb, K4, Kfb,**] Knit to end of rnd. **[48 sts.]**
6th rnd: **[ZigZag:** K5, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K3] knit to end of rnd. **[48 sts.]**
7th rnd: **[ZigZag:** K4, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K4] [Gusset: **Kfb, K6, Kfb,**] Knit to end of rnd. **[50 sts].**
8th rnd: **[ZigZag:** K3, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K5] knit to end of rnd. **[50 sts]**
9th rnd: **[ZigZag:** K2, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K6] [Gusset: **Kfb, K8, Kfb,**] Knit to end of rnd. **[52 sts.]**
10th rnd: **[ZigZag:** K3, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K5] knit to end of rnd. **[52 sts.]**
11th rnd: **[ZigZag:** K4, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K4] **Kfb, K10, Kfb,**] Knit to end of rnd. **[54 sts.]**
12th rnd: **[ZigZag:** K5, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K3] knit to end of rnd. **[54 sts.]**
13th rnd: **k2, p2, k4, p2, -- k2, -- p2, k4, p2, 4** [Gusset: Knit 14,] Slip last 14 sts just knitted onto small stitch holder (thumb opening). Knit to end of rnd. **[39 sts]**
14th rnd: **[ZigZag:** K6, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K2] **casting on 3 sts over slipped sts,** knit to end of row. [This creates a thumb hole.] **[43 sts]**

Working in rnds: Work pattern starting with Row 7 below **until** work after ribbing measures **4"**.

Dec 3 sts evenly across last rnd [in knit to end of row stitches only] just before you begin the top ribbing sts. [40 sts]

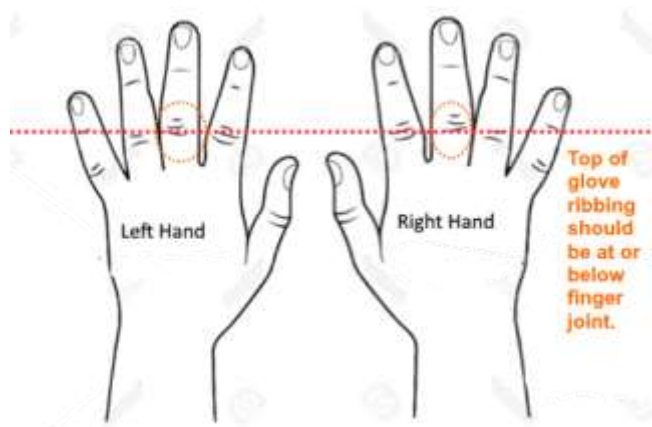
Note: I used Rows **7, 8, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8.**

PATTERN – right hand glove:

Row 1: **[ZigZag:** K2, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K6] knit to end of row.
 Row 2: **[ZigZag:** K3, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K5] knit to end of row.
 Row 3: **[ZigZag:** K4, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K4] knit to end of row.
 Row 4: **[ZigZag:** K5, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K3] knit to end of row.
 Row 5: **[ZigZag:** K6, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K2] knit to end of row.
 Row 6: **[ZigZag:** K5, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K3] knit to end of row.
 Row 7: **[ZigZag:** K4, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K4] knit to end of row.
 Row 8: **[ZigZag:** K3, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K5] knit to end of row.

Top Ribbing:

Next rnd: *K1tbl, P1, Rep from * around.
Rep last rnd of (K1tbl, P1) ribbing for 1”.



Thumb:

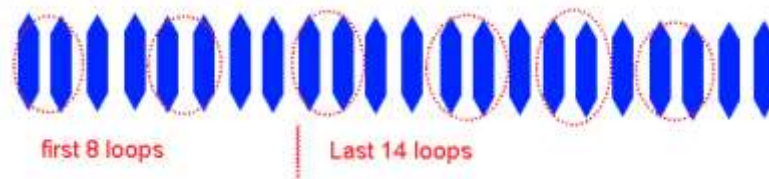
Row 1: With RS facing, join yarn to base of thumb, pick up and knit 8 sts evenly across the base. K14 from stitch holder. Divide these 22 sts onto 3 needles [**22 sts**]

Setting up loops for Thumb



Row 2: Knit around evenly. [**22sts**]

Row 3: Decrease 6 stitches. [**16 sts**]



Row 4-6: Work 3 rnds of (K1tbl, P1) ribbing. Cast off in ribbing. [**16 sts**]

Left Glove

With set of double-pointed needles, cast on **42** sts.

Divide sts evenly on 3 needles, having **14** sts on each needle. Join in rnd. PM on first st.

Wrist Ribbing:

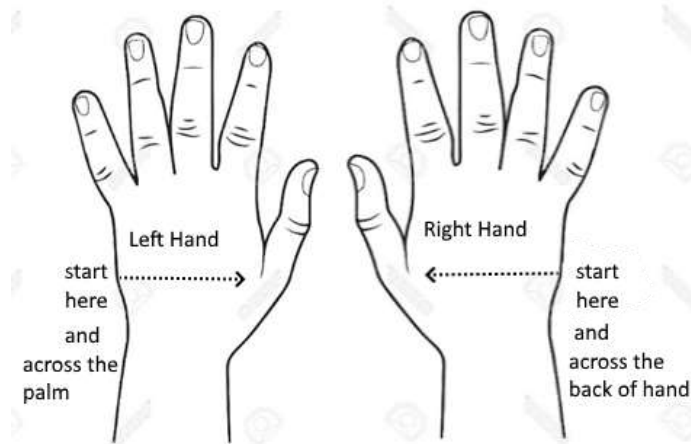
1st rnd: *K1tbl, P1, rep from * around.

Rep last rnd of (K1tbl, P1) ribbing for 3 ½”.

[Note: If you are putting a color contrast double stripe in the cuff:
1 3/8” MC, 3/8” strip CC-MC-CC, 1 3/8” MC = 3 ½” for cuff.]

do main color for 1 3/8”,
change colors,
K1tbl around,
(K1tbl, P1) ribbing for 1 row,
change color to MC,
K1tbl around,
(K1tbl, P1) ribbing for 1 row,
change color,
K1tbl around,
(K1tbl, P1) ribbing for 1 row,
change color to MC,
K1tbl around,
(K1tbl, P1) ribbing for rest of ribbing rows,

- Row 1: K18, [ZigZag: K2, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ---- P, K, P, K, P, K6]
- Row 2: K18, [ZigZag: K3, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ---- P, K, P, K, P, K5]
- Row 3: K18, [ZigZag: K4, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ---- P, K, P, K, P, K4]
- Row 4: K18, [ZigZag: K5, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ---- P, K, P, K, P, K3]
- Row 5: K18, [ZigZag: K6, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ---- P, K, P, K, P, K2]
- Row 6: K18, [ZigZag: K5, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ---- P, K, P, K, P, K3]
- Row 7: K18, [ZigZag: K4, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ---- P, K, P, K, P, K4]

Shape thumb gusset:

1st rnd: K16[Gusset: (Kfb) twice,] [ZigZag: K2, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K6] [44 sts]
2nd rnd: K16, [Gusset: K4,] [ZigZag: K3, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K5] [44 sts]
3rd rnd: K16, [Gusset: Kfb, K2, Kfb,] [ZigZag: K4, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K4] [46 sts].
4th rnd: k16, [Gusset: K6,] [ZigZag: K5, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K3] [46 sts].
5th rnd: K16, [Gusset: Kfb, K4, Kfb,] [ZigZag: K6, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K2] [48 sts].
6th rnd: K16, [Gusset: K8,] [ZigZag: K5, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K3] [48 sts].
7th rnd: K16, [Gusset: Kfb, K6, Kfb,] [ZigZag: K4, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K4] [50 sts].
8th rnd: K16, [Gusset: k10,] [ZigZag: K3, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K5] [50 sts].
9th rnd: K16, [Gusset: Kfb, K8, Kfb,] [ZigZag: K2, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K6] [52 sts].
10th rnd: K16, [Gusset: k12,] [ZigZag: K3, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K5] [52 sts]
11th rnd: K16, [Gusset: Kfb, K10, Kfb,] [ZigZag: K4, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K4] [54 sts].
12th rnd: K16, [Gusset: k14,] [ZigZag: K5, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K3] [54 sts].
13th rnd: K16, [Gusset: k14,] Slip last 14 sts from what you just knitted onto a small stitch holder (thumb opening) [ZigZag: K3, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K5] [39 sts].
14th rnd: K16, casting on 3 sts over slipped sts. [This creates a thumb hole.], [ZigZag: K5, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K3] [43 sts]

Working in rnds: Work pattern starting with Row 7 below **until** work after ribbing measures 4".

Dec 3 sts evenly across last rnd [in knit to end of row stitches only] just before you begin the top ribbing sts. [40 sts]

Note: I used Rows 7, 8, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8.

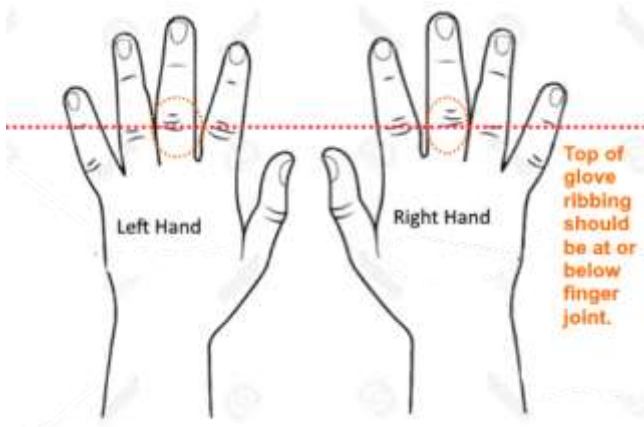
PATTERN – left hand glove:

[You can use a marker to show where to start cable sequence.]

Row 1: K16, [ZigZag: K2, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K6]
Row 2: K16, [ZigZag: K3, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K5]
Row 3: K16, [ZigZag: K4, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K4]
Row 4: K16, [ZigZag: K5, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K3]
Row 5: K16, [ZigZag: K6, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K2]
Row 6: K16, [ZigZag: K5, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K3]
Row 7: K16, [ZigZag: K4, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K4]
Row 8: K16, [ZigZag: K3, P, K, P, K, P, K6, ----- P, K, P, K, P, K5] [40 sts.]

Top Ribbing:

Next rnd: *K1tbl, P1, rep from* around.
Rep last rnd of (K1tbl, P1) ribbing for 1" Cast off in ribbing.



Thumb:

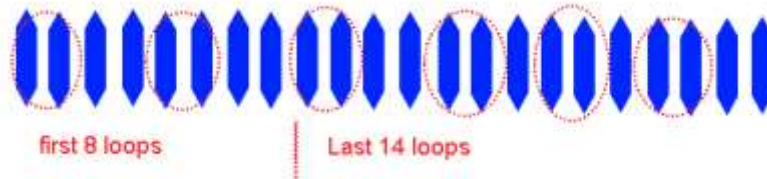
Row 1: With RS facing, join yarn to base of thumb, pick up and knit 8 sts evenly across the base. K14 from stitch holder. Divide these 22 sts onto 3 needles [22 sts]

Setting up loops for Thumb



Row 2: Knit around evenly. [22sts]

Row 3: Decrease 6 stitches. [16 sts]



Row 4-6: Work 3 rnds of (K1tbl, P1) ribbing. Cast off in ribbing. [16 sts]
