



Note: This pattern is adapted from the original pattern listed at the end of the instructions. It has three pockets instead of two and the pockets have trim as well as the outer edges. This altered pattern fits an overstuffed recliner arm.

Materials:

- 1 Skein Worsted Weight [Category 4] yarn, 4 ply (main color – MC)
- 1 Skein Worsted Weight [Category 4] yarn, 4 ply (contrasting color – CC/Trim Color)
- Crochet hook size G/6 (4.25 mm) – for body of caddy
- Crochet hook size H (5.0 mm) – for initial ch 58

Finishing Materials:

- Tapestry needle

Finished Size: 21 ½” L x 17” W

Gauge:

- 2 rows = 1” T
- 4 dc = 1” L

Skill Level: Intermediate

Caddy: (Using MC)

Instructions:

Row 1) Using H crochet hook, Ch 58, then, using G 4.25 mm hook, dc in 5th ch from hook and in each ch across: 55 dc. [Use G hook for rest of Caddy.]

Pockets:

Rnd 2) Ch 3, turn work (counts as first dc, now and throughout); dc in next dc, (working in front lps only), dc in next 15 dc, (working in both lps), *dc in next 3 dc, (working in front lps only), dc in next 15 dc, (working in both lps)*, repeat * to * once, dc in last 2 dc ----

ch 1, turn work sc in first 2 dc, (working back up the opposite side of rnd, working in the free lps to create pockets), dc in next 15 dc (the first st is a little difficult), *sc in next 3 dc, (working in free lps), dc in next 15 dc*, repeat * to * once more, sc in last 2 dc: 2 beg pockets formed with a seam between pockets.

Rnds 3-10) Ch 2, turn work; hdc in next dc, (working in front row of pocket in dc), dc in next 15 dc, *hdc in next 3 dc (seam), (working in front row of next pocket in dc), dc in next 15 dc*, repeat * to * once more, hdc in last 2 dc,

ch 1, turn work, sc in first 2 sts, dc in next 15 dc (back of pockets, same rnd), *sc in next 3 sts (seam), dc in next 15 dc (back of pockets, same rnd)*, repeat * to * once more, sc in last 2 dc. **Mark this as the RS of work with a blue marker.**

Row 11) Ch 2, turn work; hdc in next dc, dc in next 15 dc, hdc in next 3 dc (seam), dc in next 15 dc, hdc in last 2 dc, forming back of caddy: 55 dc.

Finishing pockets:

Attach trim yarn to pocket with front of pocket facing, ch1, sc across pocket. Secure end. Fasten off. Do all three pockets.

Center of Caddy [between pockets]:

Row 12: Using MC color, ch2, hdc in next stitch, dc in next 15 dc, *hdc in next 3 stitches, dc in next 15 dc*, repeat * to * once more, hdc in last 2 stitches.

Rows 13-39) Ch 3, turn work; dc in next 54 dc: 55 dc. [Note: You can make more or fewer rows here if you have a very wide arm or thin arm on the chair.]

Large End Pocket:

Row 40) Ch 3, turn work, (working in front lps only); dc in next 54 dc: 55 dc. This forms a ridge for working the bottom edging.

Rows 41-48) Ch 3, turn work, (working in both lps); dc in next 54 dc: 55dc. Fasten off; secure ends.

Row 49) Right side Facing: Using trim color, Ch1, sc across. Fasten Off. Hide Ends. 55 sc.

Ridge Row [bottom row]:

- Fold last 9 row u on front side of piece so pocket opens on same side as other pockets. [Use a cable holder or such to hold in place.]
- Wth front side facing, attach MC color to 1st back loop of ridge. Ch3, dc in each back loop of row. Finish off.

Shape Edging:

- Attach MC in first dc of the end small pocket. Ch1, 2 sc in this dc post, sc in each sc and hdc to top of pocket, then 2 sc in each dc post to top of large pocket, then, 2 sc in each dc post [back and front ones of each row so as to join both front and back together], 2 sc in last dc post.
- 3sc in top of 1st dc to form corner, sc in each dc across row, 3 sc l last dc of row to form corner.
- 2sc in first dc post, 2 sc in each dc post [front and back together] to top of large pocket.
- 2sc in each dc post to top of small pocket, sc in each sc and hdc to end of small pocket area, 2 sc in last dc post.
- 3 sc in top of 1st dc to form corner, sc in each dc to end of row, 3sc in top of last dc of row to form corner. Join to 1st sc, Finish Off.

Edge Trim:

Attach trim/CC color to any sc. Ch1, sc in each sc around with 3sc in center sc of each corner. Join to first sc. Finish Off.

Hide all ends.

Dampen and block if desired.
