

## US F, G, or H hook and using worsted medium yarn

Size: 5 chains interconnected equals 1 foot in length. [Multiply 5 chains times the desired length.]
1 ch at beginning of rows does not count as a stitch.

- Make 25 ch - join to beginning chain.
- Row $1: 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in second ch from hook, 1 sc in each ch to end, join with sl st to $1^{\text {st }}$ st of row. (24 dc)
- Row 2: $1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in each sc to end, join with sl st to $1^{\text {st }}$ st of row.
- Rows 3: Same as Row 2.
- Repeat rows 1-3 for each chain piece needed for desired length of chain group.
- On second piece and subsequent pieces, wrap chain [without twisting the chains] around the previous piece with outside of piece facing out.
- Then join the chain.
- Always have front side facing outside. Hide ends.


You might want to stitch with tapestry needle the pieces in place. If so do so inside the chain piece so stitching does not show.
