Multiple of 10 + edging stitches on both sides

Knitting Needles 3.0 mm

Yarn ~ 100% cotton Category 4

Size:

7 ½" x 7 ½" appx 1 set [12 rows] = 1 ½"

4 rows = $\frac{1}{2}$ "

No top/bottom borders, just cast on row and bind off row

BUTTON IN A SQUARE DISHCLOTH PATTERN

Cast on 36 stitches

Pattern:

Row 1 [RS]: K3, *k1, p8, k1*; repeat from * to* 2 more times, K3 [bottom of box] Row 2 [WS]: K3, *p1, k8, p1*; repeat from * to * 2 more times, K3 [bottom of box]

Row 3, 5 & 7 [RS]: K3, *k1, p2, k4, p2, k1*; repeat from * to * 2 more times, K3 [center of box] Rows 4, 6 & 8 [WS]: K3, *p1, k2, p4, k2, p1*; repeat from * to * 2 more times, K3 [center of box]

Row 9 [RS]: Same as row 3 [top of box]
Row 10 [WS]: Same as row 4 [top of box]

Row 11 [RS]: K3, knit across, K3 [dividing line] Row 12 [WS]: K3, purl across, K3 [dividing line]

Repeat rows 1-12 <u>three times</u> more and then rows 1-10 [Total 4 Sets of 1-12 rows and then rows 1-10]

Bind off using knit method.
