Faux Cable Dishcloth Pattern

Multiple of 5 sts plus 2 Use **3.5 needles** and 100% cotton yarn [category 4]

Size: 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " 1 set [rows 1-4] = 3/5" Border top/bottom = $\frac{1}{4}$ " each

Additional Abbreviations:

- Wyib = With Yarn in Back
- **Psso** = <u>Pass Slip Stitch Over [over the 2 knit stitches]</u>
- YO = <u>Yarn Over purl-wise [from front wrap over needle then back to front to do next stitch]</u>
- **SI 1** = slip stitch purl-wise

Cast on 36 stitches $[5 \times 6 = 30 + 2 + 4 = 36]$

Knit 2 rows

Pattern:

• Row 1 (RS): **K2** *p2, k3*; repeat * to * 6 times, p2, **K2** repeat from * to * 6 times, Row 2: **K2** <mark>*k2, p3*</mark>; k2, K2 Row 3: **K2** *p2, Wyib, sl 1 stitch, k2, Psso*; repeat * to * 6 times, p2, K2 Row 4: **K2** *k2, p1, YO, p1*; repeat from * to * 6 times, k2, K2

Repeat rows 1-4 <u>eleven more times then repeat rows 1 and 2 once more</u> [Total 12 sets and then rows 1 & 2]

Purl 1 row, then bind off using purl method.

Sets: [12 sets and rows 1 & 2]
