


# Simple Cable Ear Warmer



20" long and join ends together



## Size:

- 5" wide by 20-21" long

## Materials:

- 4.0 mm straight needles
- Tapestry needle to sew ends together and hide ends
- Crochet hook 4.0 mm for cast on
- Worsted weight yarn [category 4] – use a soft yarn [less than 3 oz]

Abbreviations: [research on internet how to do any stitch you don't know]

- CO = cast on
- BO = bind off
- K = knit
- P = purl
- Crochet-cast-on = use the crochet hook and do a crochet cast on.
- RS = right side of ear warmer
- WS = wrong side of ear warmer

### **Body of Ear Warmer:**

CO 30 using crochet method and 4.0 mm crochet hook.

Pattern:

- RS -- Row 1: (K4), K2, P2, K4, P2, K2, P2, K4, P2, K2, (K4) [There are 30 loops on needle.]
- WS – Row 2: (K4), P2, K2, P4, K2, P2, K2, P4, K2, P2, (K4)
- RS – Row 3: (K4), K2, P2, put 2 loops on cable holder, K2, knit the two loops from the cable holder, P2, K2, P2, put 2 loops on cable holder, K2, knit the two loops from the cable holder, P2, K2, (K4)
- WS – Row 4: (K4), P2, K2, P4, K2, P2, K2, P4, K2, P2, (K4)

Repeat rows 1-4 of pattern until 19-21" long. [Length depends on how large head is.]

### **Finishing:**

- BO
- Sew ends together on wrong side. Hide ends.
- Block
