

Free Pattern: Small Snowflake Wishes 1

Materials Used:

- Cotton Crochet Thread #3 or Cotton Category 2 yarn
- 1.90 mm steel hook
- optional materials for blocking: water, PVA glue and glitter, or spray starch

Size: 3 1/2" diameter with #3 thread or 3 3/4" with Category 2 yarn

USA Stitches used:

ch, sl st, sc, dc. Optional

US Instructions:


Make a magic circle.

Round 1: ch3, dc 11 times into loop, sl st into 3rd ch of ch3/starting dc to join.

Round 2: ch5, sc in next st, ch3, *sc into next st, ch5, sc in next st, ch3* five times, sl st into first st to join.

Round 3: sl st into first ch5 loop, ch3 (or make chainless starting dc), dc4, ch3, skip ch3 loop, *dc5 in next loop, ch3, skip ch3 loop,* 5 times, sl st into 3rd ch of ch3/starting dc to join.

Round 4: Ch1, (sc, ch4, sc,) in next st, (sc, ch6, sc,) in next st, (sc, ch4, sc,) in next st, sc, ch3, *sc in next st (skip ch3 from prev round), (sc, ch4, sc) in next st, (sc, ch6, sc) in next st, (sc, ch4, sc) in next st, sc, ch3,* five times, join with sl st to ch1 at start of round. Bind off, weave in ends.



Blocking: Blocking with PVA and glitter is messy but to my mind, worth it. Here's a picture of the steps I go through, followed by an explanation. Of course, you can leave your snowflakes unblocked or block them with spray starch instead.
